To: Our Veterans,

Just a short letter to inform you of services that we provide for our disabled/physically challenged veterans. We treasure, honor, and respect our veterans. For this reason our staff will leave no stone unturned to provide individual attention to your driving mobility needs, as well as your home needs. We will discuss and acquaint the Vet. with their related adaptive equipment benefits. Those that are "Service Connected Veterans" we can help them find out if they are entitled to benefits. Those Veterans that have become disabled while they were in active service (PEACE TIME OR WAR TIME) or had the onset of symptoms (such as multiple sclerosis or ALS) of a disease while in active duty. If this occurs the VA allows the Veteran to select the vehicle modifier of choice and to have the modifications of the vehicle to be installed. After written prior authorization from the appropriate VAMC prosthetics chief. We can also provide help in getting your authorization. Typically, the Veteran acquires the vehicle to be modified and if it's the first vehicle that is eligible for the program by the Veterans, there is a one-time grant of \$9000.00 by the VA. We can help them get it, once the Veteran has been determined to be "SERVICE CONNECTED" and eligible for the VA'S Automobile Grant Program..... They are entitled to purchase two vehicles every four years following "protocol" is required throughout the process. We will also be able to provide information about the Automobile Manufacturers Mobility Rebate Programs....that many vehicle manufacturers offer... Many vehicle manufacturers help people pay for the adaptive equipment. "WE WILL TELL VETERANS ABOUT THEM AND THE REBATES THEY OFFER" and other sources of finance to help....
